This annual camp is held at Camp Byng on the Sunshine Coast. You should already have your personal invite! We will meet on Saturday June 18th, 2011 at the foot passenger booth at the Horseshoe Bay Ferry Ticket Booth at 8:15 am. A leader will be on hand to arrange to get everyone on the ferry under our reservation. We have arranged for a luggage cart to load our gear on. We will be met at the other end by a bus for passengers, and vans for the gear. We are not permitted to carry luggage on the bus. We will be returning to Horseshoe Bay on Sunday at 3:10 pm.

Beavers and Leaders should travel in uniform, both To and From camp.

Please: Clearly identify all personal property! Each Person needs to Bring:

- Sleeping bag (or blankets), pillow.

You will be sleeping in unheated tarpaulin roof huts with plywood floors and walls (hulls). Evenings and mornings can be cool at Camp Byng; you might want a blanket or 2 to go over or under your sleeping bag. Fleece clothing normally works better than cotton to keep warm!!

- Pajamas or sweats
- (Include a toque and mitts as it gets cooler in the evening)
- 2 pairs each: shorts, long pants & underwear
- 3 pairs socks (minimum)
- 2 T-shirts & 2 sweat-shirts
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Jacket & rain gear, boots & spare sneakers / runners
- Sun hat & sunscreen
- Towel, face cloth, soap, comb, toothbrush & paste
- Flashlight & spare batteries
- Campfire blanket if you have one this is a great place to wear it!

Optional Items:

More spare clothes, teddy bear, story book, sweater, insect repellant, lawn chairs, Frisbee, ball, sunglasses, binoculars, camera

PLEASE:

No knives, money, candy, electronic games, TV's, radios, homework or pets.

Campers will be divided into Lodges for Camp Activities. Chores will be assigned to lodges. Parents will be asked to help with kitchen duties before and after each meal. <u>Each Lodge will be asked to prepare a song, skit or cheer for our campfire on Saturday night. Bring an idea or two with you!</u> (We will have resource books with ideas on hand too).

Allergies, Medication & Unusual Meal Requirements: Must be reported clearly on our Busy Beaver Registration form so staff is aware of allergies, dietary requirements and any physical limitations. Parents will be responsible for administering any/all medication to their child.
